The trout is from Saaremaa, but not organic.
****	Organic food or eco-food is labelled with the European Union organic logo, which is mandatory for all organic products. It is on <u>all BabyCool products</u> except trout puree cubes. The trout is from Saaremaa, but not organic.
Saaremaa ehtne toode	"Genuine Saaremaa Product" (Saaremaa Ehtne Toode in Estonian) is a label that indicates the regional origin of a product or service – the product or service is made in a clean natural environment of Saaremaa and Muhumaa, with the work and experience of local people. It is on all BabyCool products including trout puree cubes. Trout puree cubes are made from fish grown in Saaremaa!
A SON WASHINGTON	BabyCool products are marked with the label of the Estonian Allergy Association, as we have received their approval. It is on all BabyCool products except trout puree cubes. Trout puree cubes do not have the label of the Estonian Allergy Association, since they are allergens.
